

What are membership costs?

Initiation Fee

The initiation fee is a one-time fee due at signing. Remaining balance due within 60 days of opening. For both membership types (individual/family), this fee is based solely on their age at the time of signing.

Monthly Dues

Monthly dues are based on age and membership type. The members’ ages are recalculated on January 1 of every calendar year. The family membership dues are 50% more than the individual membership dues.

Food Minimum

A monthly food minimum applies to all guests, regardless of membership type and age. The minimum is \$75/month.

What is the difference between an individual and a family membership?

An individual membership is for one person. A spouse may use the dining and social areas without the member. A family membership allows both adults full use of all facilities in the club independent of each other. It also allows one or both adults to bring their children under age 21 to enjoy the family friendly areas of the club.

Is the initiation fee refundable?

No.

What are the payment terms for the initiation fee?

A \$1,500 check (\$750 for under 30 years of age) is due upon acceptance to secure membership spot. The balance is due 60 days prior to opening.

What happens if I move?

If you move, you may suspend your membership for up to 1 year or you may terminate membership at any time. You may also adjust your membership type to an “out of town” membership for non-locals.

How will my monthly dues be charged?

Charges will be billed automatically to a card or bank account on file. Late fees will be assessed. Members will receive a 2.5% discount if monthly dues are paid up front annually by check or wire.

What if I don’t spend my monthly food minimum?

You must spend the monthly minimum by the end of each quarter. Any outstanding balance will be billed to your account.

Will dues escalate over time?

Over time, it is expected that monthly dues will escalate moderately to accommodate for increases in operating costs.

**What is included in my membership fee?**

Members will have access to the entire club including restaurants, bars, lounges, all fitness areas and the pool, plus all of our extensive exclusive programming including group fitness. These are all members-only areas. Members will also be given access to The Study on both a reserved and “as-available” basis.

**What charges are not included in my membership?**

All food and drink purchases, dedicated co-working space, office suites, private room/event space rentals, hotel, spa services, private/semi-private training, golf lessons, pilates, child care, select special events and parking are à la carte and will be billed directly to your account.

**How much do these amenities cost?**

Pricing is consistent with the cost of these services at other private clubs, gyms, co-working spaces and restaurants. We will share pricing with our members as we get closer to opening. Parking will be discounted for members and will be based on length of stay.

**How many members will be accepted?**

The Club will open with approximately 1,000 members. Membership will initially be limited to 2,500 members.

**What is the membership process?\***

Each applicant is required to provide two referrals and complete a Membership Application. Prospective members will interview with the Club’s Membership Committee and a Club representative. We are committed to assembling a diverse group of members representing leaders, influencers etc. across all industries and backgrounds.

**Are there reciprocal clubs?**

Not yet. We have plans to expand our own network of clubs, however our concierge can help identify preferred accommodations and dining recommendations in other cities.

**Are children allowed in the club?**

Yes! Fittler Club embraces the lifestyle of our members and our members have busy lives filled with work, family and social time. We offer a family membership option and a variety of spaces to meet each families desires and goals...

- Children are always welcome to dine with their families in our restaurants.
- Children may enjoy the pool (with adult supervision) with the exception of adult swim hours. Swim programs will be offered.
- Regular family friendly programming will include activities like kids movie nights in the screening room, game nights, and weekend kids classes among others.
- Parents are welcome to leave children (over 18 months) in the playroom for up to 2 hours (\$10 per hour). Parents must stay in the club and be available should their child need them (parents will be called to change diapers or assist children to the bathroom).
- Children under the age of 16 must always be accompanied by an adult

### **When do kids age out of family membership?**

When a child turns 21, they may apply for membership as an individual.

### **What is the guest policy?**

Members may invite up to 3 guests at a time. Contact the manager for larger parties. Guests may not use the fitness or pool/spa areas at any time. Members will be able to purchase up to 4 guest passes in a calendar year.

### **Who has access to hotel rooms?**

The hotel is available for outside reservation on a limited basis. Members have preferred rates.

### **Can hotel guests use the club?**

Hotel guests are effectively members for their length of stay and have access to the club as a member does.

### **Is there a dress code?**

There is no formal dress code - we are calling it occasion appropriate - use your judgment.

### **Can we use our cell phone or take pictures?**

No photography of members or guests is allowed. Everyone is to feel at home at the club and not worry if their hair looks good. Pictures are permitted in the outdoor spaces and in the lobbies. Photographers are allowed for private events. Please limit your cell phone usage in public spaces; phone calls are permitted in the co-working spaces, outdoors and in the lobby areas.

### **Can I book a private event now?**

Yes! Members will have priority and preferred rates for booking all event spaces. Spaces available: Ballroom, Boardroom, Trophy Room, Private Dining Rooms, Screening Room, and more... We are booking events now for January 2019 and beyond.

### **Do I need to make reservations in the main restaurant?**

Reservations are strongly encouraged. Those with reservations will receive preferential seating. The Back Bar will not take reservations.

### **Are pets allowed?**

None are permitted within the club other than verified service animals.

### **Is there parking?**

We have 50 dedicated spots for club members. Members may park for 2-3 hours while at the club for \$7-\$10. All day parking is \$50. We will also offer valet service and car service, running loops through the Market St corridor of Center City.

**Can I bring my own trainer?**

No. We will have world-class private training and group fitness for all levels to accommodate all of your health and wellness needs.

**\*Membership Process:**

By completing the Fitler Club's (the "Club") application for membership, you are authorizing the Club's membership committee to verify the information in your application. The verification process may include, but is not limited to, interviewing you, contacting your references, performing a background check and obtaining a credit verification report for you. The committee also may request additional information from you as part of its consideration of your application. The committee will send you a written notice of whether your membership has been approved. The committee may approve or reject your membership in its sole discretion, subject to the requirements of law. Continued membership in the Club is predicated on you and your guests complying with Club rules and paying Club dues and fees.
